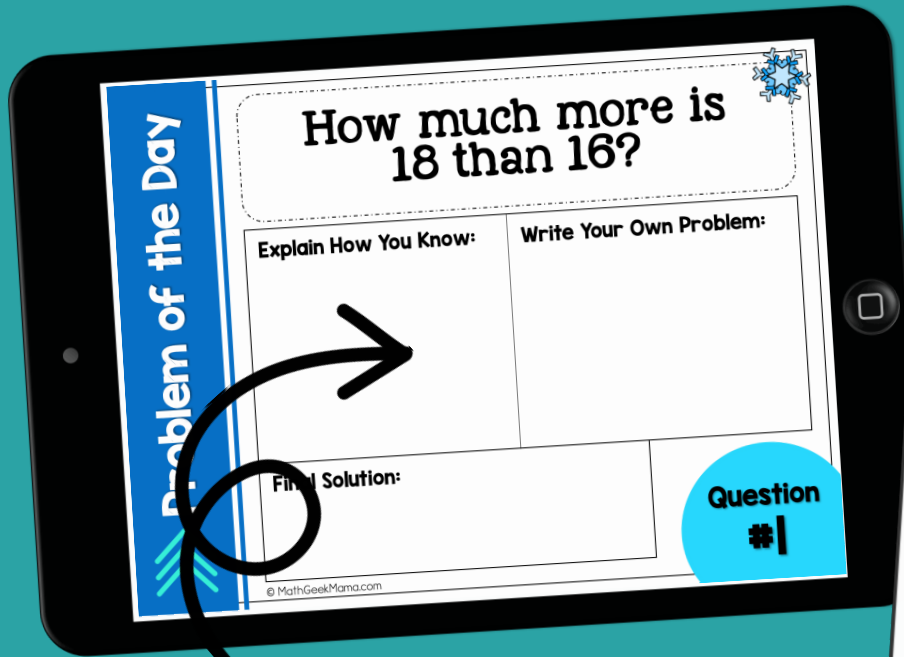
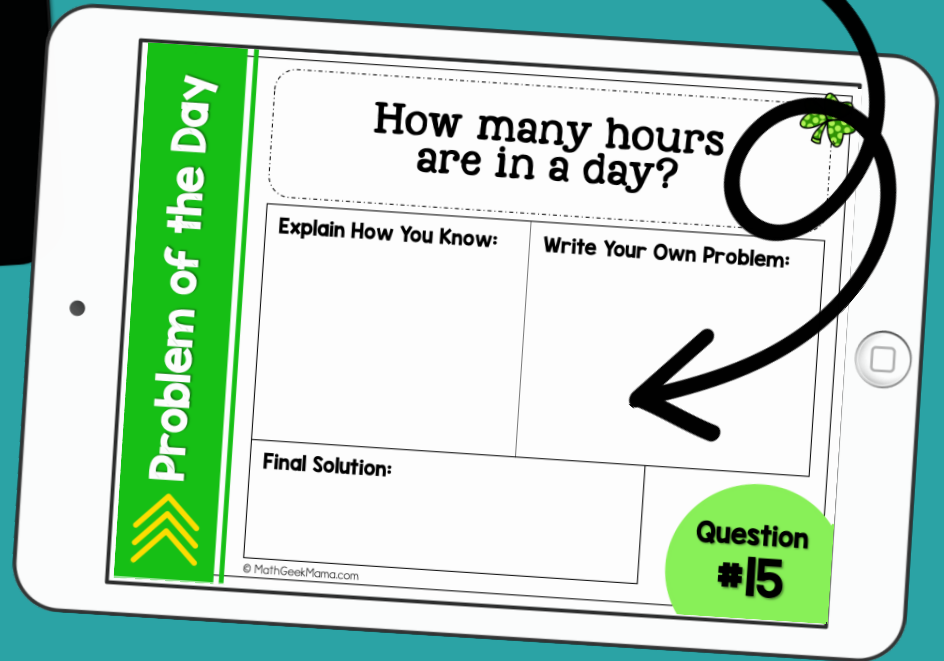


Math Problem of the Day

Math Problem of the Day

Each month includes slides with a different theme:

- Worksheet 11 (Bottom Far Right):** Problem: "Find the missing value: $15 - ? = 13$ ".

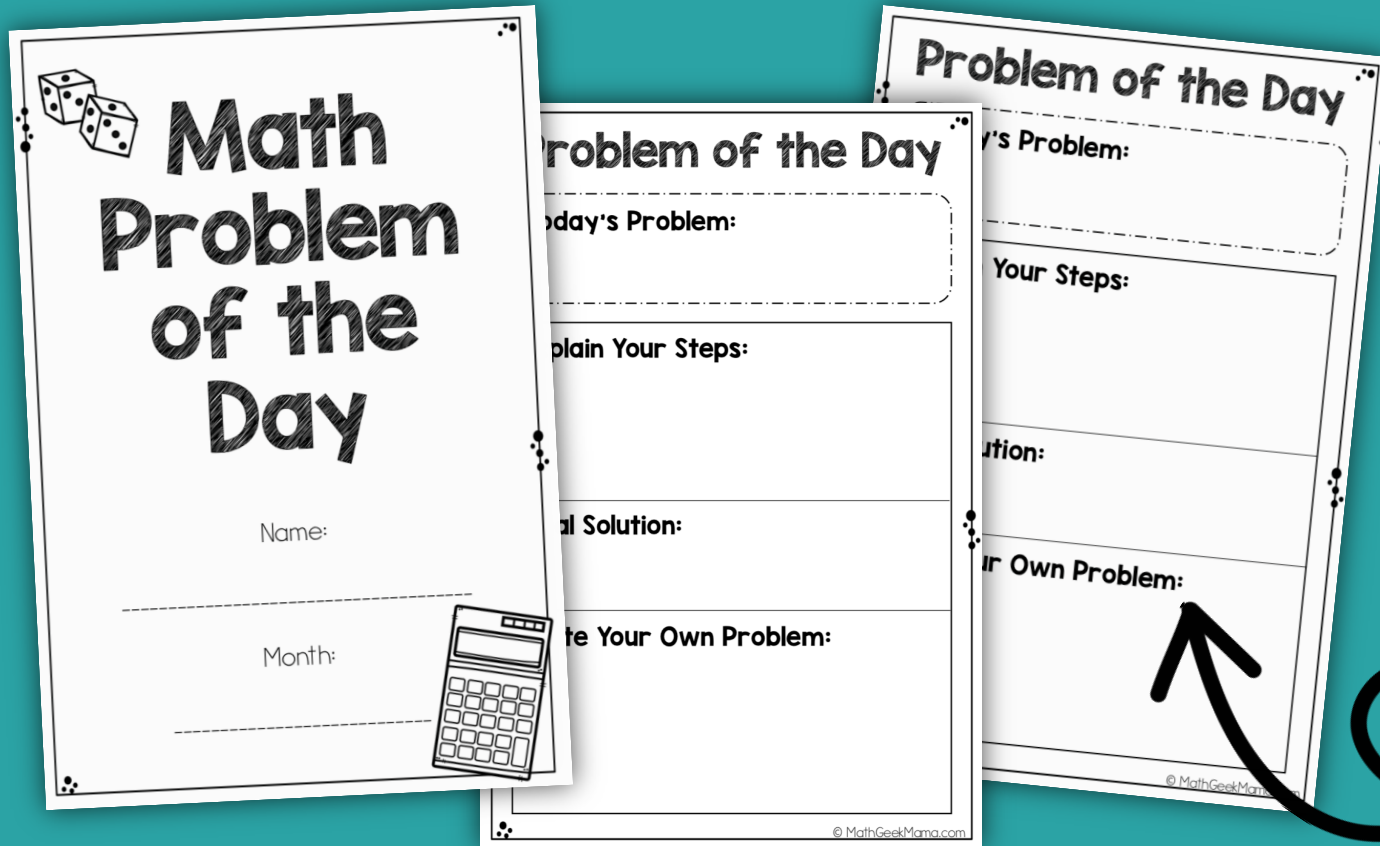
